Subject to the provisions of, Gujarat Right of Education to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, made under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 The Certificate of Recognition is hereby grant to the Manager, **Amrit Vidyalaya** situated at Aata, Alva Malav Road, Ta – Kalol, Dist Panchmahal. (hereinafter called "**the certificate**" for **class I to VIII** standard for the period **3 years** (no. of years) from the academic year **2024** to **2026** in compliance to section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education, rules of Acts 2009 and Act 2012.

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The grant for recognition is available initially for classes **I to VIII** standard and to be extended for Secondary /Senior Secondary classes subsequently in due course of time.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (35 of 2009), the Gujarat Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, the guidelines issued by the Government of India and the State Government and any instructions, directions or Government Resolutions.
3. The school shall admit in pre-school / class I to the extent of **25** (%age) of the strength in each class,

children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

4. Taking capitation fee is prohibited and therefore the trust Society or School shall not collect any capitation fee or in any way other donations or articles in lieu of such fees.
5. The school shall not adopt in any way any screening test or procedure of the child or his or her parents or guardians for the purposes of admission.
6. The school shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof or on the ground of religion, caste, creed or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The school shall ensure that,-
 - a. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - b. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - c. No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - d. Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 30.
 - e. The students with disabilities or special needs are admitted/included as per provision of the Act.
 - f.
 - i). The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid by the National Council of Teachers Education and the State Government or such authority authorized under 23(1) (rule/ clause of the state Act). Also see tht the qualifications prescribed by the Government Resolution, Education Dept, No. PRE-1110-223-K dated 27th April, 2011 is complied with.
 - ii). Provided further that the current teachers who at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 year.
 - iii). Any new teacher who is recruited after the publication of the Government Resolution, Education Dept, No. PRE-1110-223-K dated 27th April, 2011, shall be required to pass the prescribed Teachers Eligibility Test (TET) of respective group.
 - iv). The school shall adhere to students-teacher ratio prescribed in the schedule to the Act or as the case may be, the ratio prescribed by the clause (d) of sub-rule (1) of the rule -13 if school has classrooms of lesser size that 300 sq.feet, whichever is less. The recruitment of teachers

- shall be in accordance with the requirement specified in the schedule.
- v). The rules governing the salary and allowances payable to to and the terms and conditions of service of teachers. Made by the State Government shall apply:
 - vi). The teachers perform his duties specified under 24 (1) Act.
 - vii). The teacher shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.
 - viii). A transparent and fair admission process is followed adhering to guidelines and direction issued by the Central or State Government or The Director.
 - ix). Any regulation, direction, instruction or guidelines issued from time to time by the State Government or the Director of Primary Education with regard to the fee to be charged from the students shall be strictly followed.
8. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
 9. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
 10. The school shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Act and comply with all the conditions of Rule 13, particularly those pertaining to furnishing of any information, maintenance of website or the school and filling the DISE data correctly and truthfully every year within stipulated time.
 11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
 12. The school building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not be carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respect are under whole responsibility of the managements.
 13. The school is run by a society registered under the Act of 1860 (21 of 1860, or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
 14. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
 15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared.
 16. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority

from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

17. The recognition Code Number allotted to your school is _____. This may be pleased noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.
18. The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any stage/ time.
19. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities.
20. The management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to this **Office of District Primary Education Officer, Godhra, Panchmahal.**
21. The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/ Department form time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the school.
22. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rule or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.

The school management shall have to full responsibility if any court cases arises this regard. The management is not entitled to seek affiliation to other Board without obtaining NOC from the Department of Education, Gujarat. (Concerned State Authority).
